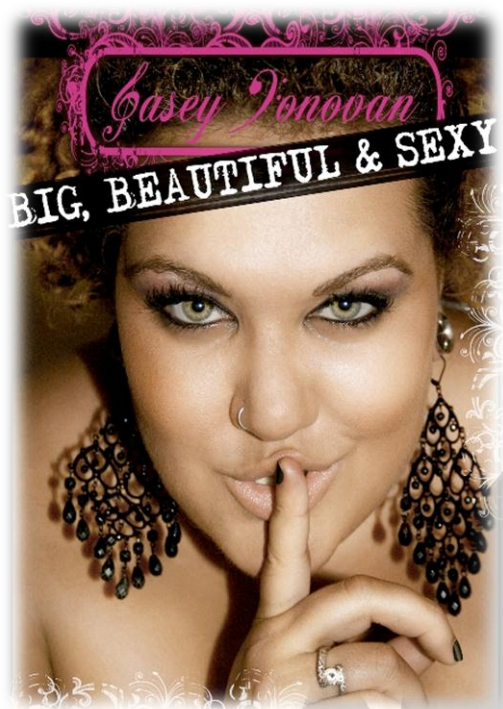


CASEY CONTINUES HER ACCLAIMED *BIG, BEAUTIFUL & SEXY* TOUR THROUGHOUT 2011
